DEDICATION OF STUDIES

MEMORANDA

Boys are asked to study the following and, by their diligent observance of them, promote the efficiency and good name of the College.

HOUSE RULES

1. In dealing with priests and masters, boys should show respect, standing when addressed, not having their hands in their pockets; many other ways will suggest themselves.
2. Boys should always be cleanly and neatly dressed. On Sundays the school uniform (white shirt, school tie, blazer and dark slacks) is to be worn until after dinner. Shoes should be polished; tennis shoes should not be worn in the chapel, refectory and classrooms.
3. All should write home at least once a week; parcels and gifts should be acknowledged immediately.
4. Care should be taken not to damage the property of the College or of others; breakages should be reported.
5. Waste-paper should be put in the baskets provided and not thrown about either indoors or outside. Books or other belongings should not be left about.
6. There is quiet in the lavatories always, in the dormitories and washrooms at night, and in the libraries.

7. Visiting hours are: Sundays and Half-days, 2-5.30 p.m. Visitors should not be brought to the dormitories or corridors. Permission to leave the College grounds should be asked from the Prefect. Boys absent from class or study should tell the Headmaster.
8. It is forbidden: to keep edibles, money or valuables in the dormitory; money should be lodged with the Prefect for safe-keeping.
9. It is forbidden to bring into or have in the College books, magazines or papers without the Prefect's approval.
10. Smoking is strictly forbidden, except to First Club with parents' written permission, at the time and place appointed by First Prefect.
11. Study Hall: Silence should be kept entering the study hall and during study; anything which disturbs the study of other boys should be avoided.
12. Classroom: While waiting for class, boys should be quiet and remain in their places. When the Master comes in, all rise and say the usual prayers. Boys should not stay in classrooms at the "break".
13. All must take part in the school games. Those who wish to be exempted for reasons of health should ask Father Minister's permission immediately after breakfast and tell their Prefect without delay.
14. Day Boys: While in the college they are subject to the same discipline and have the same bounds as the boarders. If absent they should bring a letter of explanation to the Headmaster. They must take their normal part in school games and activities.
15. Any boarder going into, coming out of, or found in a public house, will be liable to expulsion.
16. All should know the rules of the dormitories, refectory, libraries, bounds, study and classrooms.
